



BRIEF DESCRIPTION

The Institute of Education Sciences (IES) awarded \$6 million to the Kentucky Center for Education & Workforce Statistics (KCEWS) for the project, "Expanding Access to & Alignment of Education & Workforce Data to Inform Policy & Practice."
