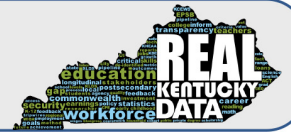


SNAP - FY17 Data & Technical Assistance

BRIEF DESCRIPTION

This project will enable Kentucky to develop the technical capacity to meet the requirements of federal reporting. Once Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program Employment & Training (SNAP E&T) data are integrated with the education & workforce data in the Kentucky Longitudinal Data System (KLDS), Kentucky will be able to address state needs related to improving workforce participation & increasing education, job training & workforce alignment.

- Integrated additional quarters of SNAP E&T participant data within the KLDS.
- Prepared and submitted FY 18 SNAP E&T annual report.
- Refined SNAP E&T metrics for federal reporting.

- Integrate SNAP comprehensive dataset.
- Run & test guardian/dependent match.

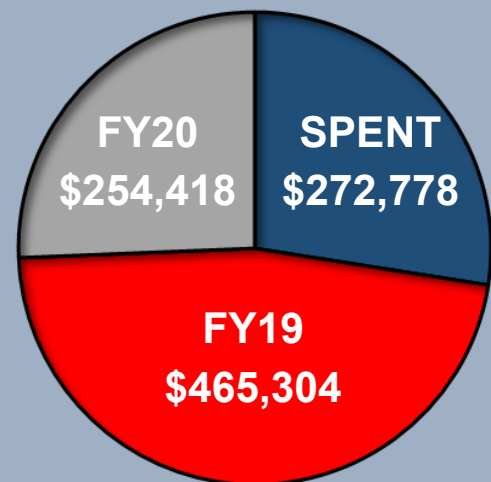
