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<sup>1</sup> For the purpose of this report, race refers to White Non-Hispanic, and Nonwhite (which includes White Hispanic and all other races regardless of ethnicity).

The 2016 population estimates contained in the following tables were developed from population estimates released by the University of Louisville, Kentucky State Data Center, and the U.S. Census Bureau.

Labor force estimates for sex and race for 2016 were produced using Local Area Unemployment Statistics (LAUS), 2012-2016 American Community Survey 5-Year Estimates, and the 2016 Current Population Survey.

County level labor force estimates by sex and race were developed using ratios based upon the 2012-2016 American Community Survey 5-Year Estimates.

The estimates contained in this publication should be used for Affirmative Action purposes only and are not comparable with estimates released in earlier publications.
