

High School Graduating Class of 2014

The Kentucky High School Feedback Report is produced by the Kentucky Center for Education and Workforce Statistics utilizing data from the Kentucky Longitudinal Data System (KLDS), which includes data from the Kentucky Department of Education, Kentucky Council on Postsecondary Education, and the Kentucky Higher Education Assistance Authority. This report provides the most complete and accurate data about college going that exists for this district. It follows students who graduated from public high schools in 2013-14 and were enrolled in a college or university during the 2014-15 academic year.

A. Overall, how do 2013-14 graduates from this district compare to others in Kentucky?





College Going Rates Compared to Previous Graduating Classes



College Going Rates for Graduates by Demographic Characteristics




